

The CHCI Postgraduate Fellowship Program (PGF) enhances participants' leadership abilities, strengthens professional skills, and produces more competent and competitive Latino professionals. This nine-month paid program offers exceptional Latinos exposure to a network of leaders and unparalleled hands-on experience in a variety of public policy areas, which may include: Child Welfare, Clean Energy, Health, Housing, International Affairs, K-12 Education, Law, and Technology. Participants will complete their first-half placement in a congressional office on Capitol Hill and will have the opportunity to pursue a second-half placement that best matches their policy interests. The range of placements includes congressional offices, committees, federal agencies, the White House, national non-profit advocacy organizations, and government-related institutions. Postgraduate Fellows will also enhance their professional skills by producing a policy brief and organizing a policy briefing on Capitol Hill.

Applicants to the Postgraduate Fellowship Program must have completed a master's degree or JD within two years prior to the program start date.
